Dear Parents,

Our Year 6 visit to Kingswood (19th-21st October) is finally here. We are not sure how the weather will be so we are advising everyone to bring some extra clothes, underwear and towels. During the visit the children will take part in a variety of activities. **All activities require your child to wear long sleeves, trousers, shoes/boots and waterproofs or they will be unable to participate in that activity.** Please do not go out and buy new clothes-old clothing is fine as they will get very dirty. . ***Please see packing list on the back of this letter.*** Children can now bring up to £10 pocket money to spend in the gift shop. Miss Fredson will be collecting all money in the hall before we depart.

Please ensure that all medication to be given is clearly labelled with the dosage and given to Miss Evans before we depart. **Any children that are asthmatic must have their inhaler with them at all times or they will be unable to take part in activities.**

Please bring your child and any bags/suitcases to the **junior hall at 1:15 pm** on Wednesday 19th October where we will collect any pocket money and medication and depart shortly after.

Children are not allowed to bring aerosol deodorants as they set off the smoke alarms (and will be confiscated), mobile phones or expensive electrical items. We would encourage the use of disposable cameras as digital cameras can get easily damaged during activities or lost.

Please make sure your child has eaten lunch at home before coming to school as they will not be allowed to eat on the coach. Please **do not pack lots of additional food for your child** as there are plenty of opportunities to eat while away and a great variety of choices at every mealtime! If you would like to pack some cereal bars or a biscuits as a snack that would be fine.

We will be returning to school on Friday 21st October at approximately 2.00pm.

We are really looking forward to the visit.

Packing List

Please use the following checklist to help pack bags: **(please put your child's name on all items of clothing)**

- One bath towel
- Toilet bag containing: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush etc
bobbles for girls
- Pyjamas / slippers
- Lots of socks and underwear
- T-shirts, (at least one with long-sleeves), sweatshirt /fleece
- Four pairs of trousers or tracksuit bottoms
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Wellingtons and trainers (old pairs)
- Bin bag for dirty clothes
- Gloves, hat, scarf (in winter)
- Water bottle with name on
- ***No aerosol deodorants(only roll on)***
