Dear Parents/ carers,

On Friday 22nd September 2017, we will be holding a 'wear yellow' non-uniform day to raise money for 'Lucy's Pineapple fund'. We will be asking for a voluntary contribution of 50p in exchange for the children coming to school in non-uniform – yellow if possible.



Lucy's Pineapple Fund is a charity raising money for a local girl, Lucy Maroney (aged 9) who has been recently diagnosed with Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG), a terminal, inoperable and (so far) untreatable malignant brain tumour. The tumour is Grade 4, meaning Lucy is expected to have only months to live. Since her diagnosis, Lucy has begun treatment of Intra-arterial chemotherapy treatment under Dr. Alberto Siller and Dr. Alberto Garcia in Monterrey, Mexico. However, this treatment is extremely expensive. The charity is aiming to raise £300,000 to support Lucy and research into DIPG.

To help with this we will be holding a sponsored 'bounceathon' where the children will aim to complete 300,000 bounces using a variety of balls/ activities. We would appreciate if you could collect any sponsorship money using the attached sponsor form and return to school by the 29th September.
