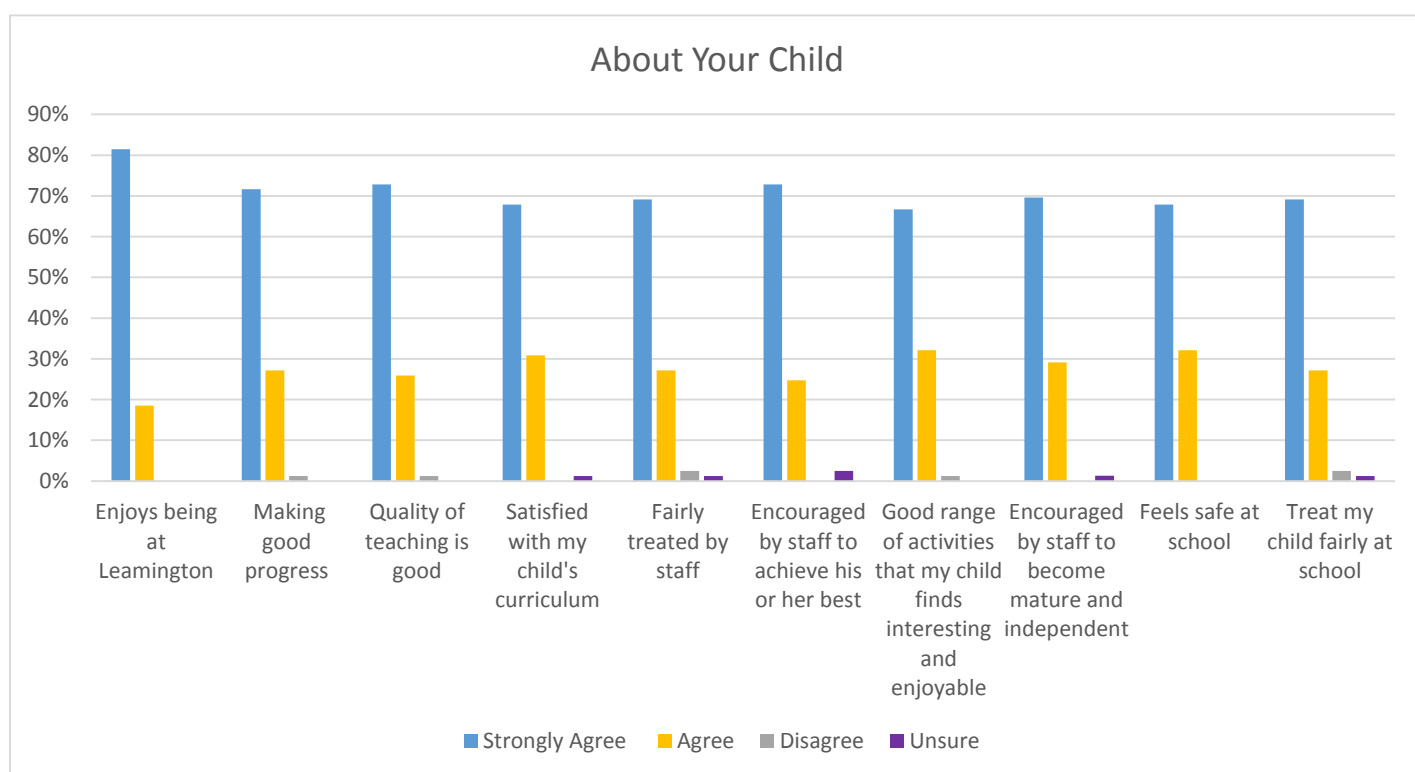


Parent Questionnaire 2016 – 81 Returned (20%)

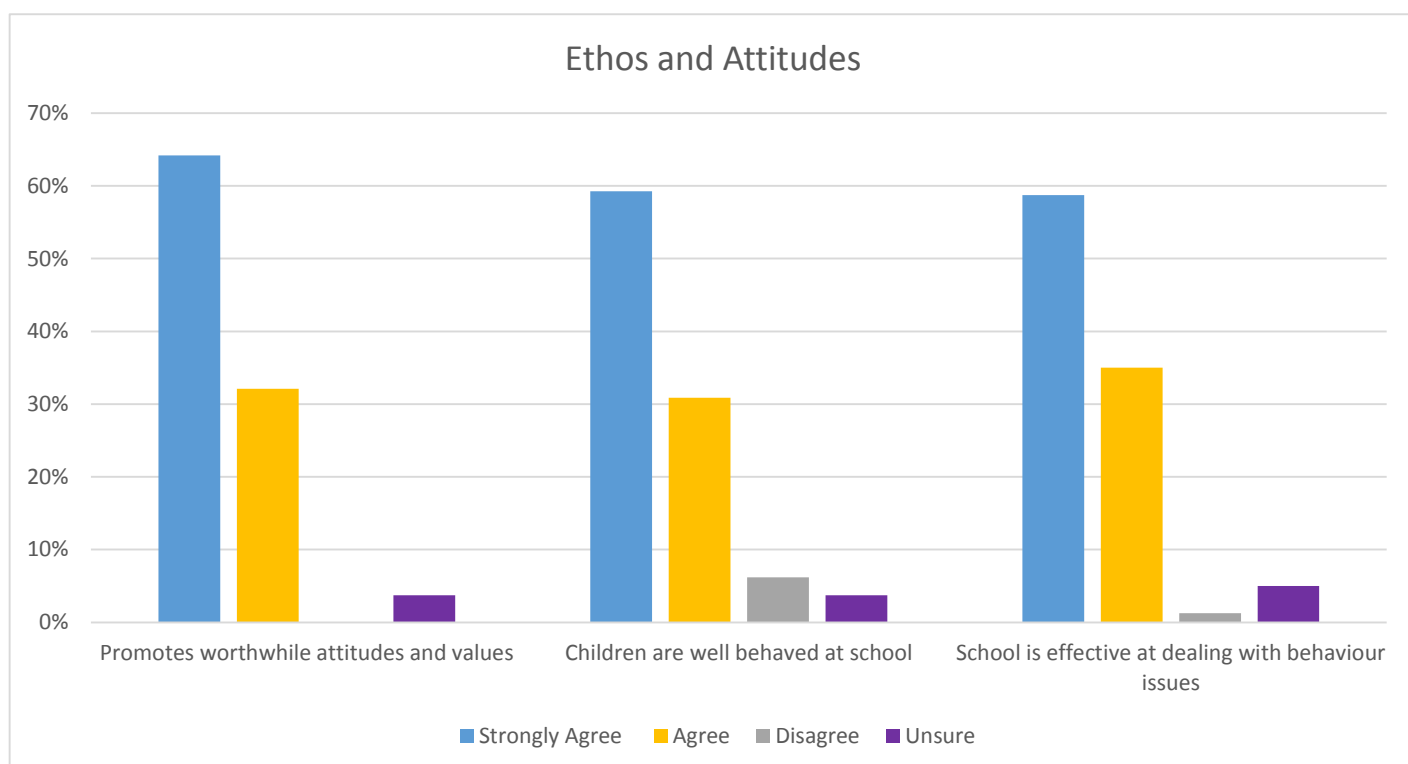
About Your Child

- All parents say their child enjoys being at Leamington, with 81% strongly agreeing and 19% agreeing.
- Most parents agree that their child is making good progress, just 1% disagree.
- The quality of child’s teaching is mostly agreed as being good but 1% disagree.
- 68% strongly agree that they are satisfied with the curriculum with 31% agreeing, while 1% are unsure.
- The majority of parents feel their child is treated fairly by staff with 69% strongly agreeing and 27% agreeing. However 2% disagree and another 1% are unsure.
- 73% strongly agree and a further 25% agree that staff encourage their child to achieve their best while 2% are unsure.
- Most parents agreed that there is a good range of interesting and enjoyable activities, 67% strongly agreed and 32% agreed. Although 1% were unsure.
- 70% of parents strongly agree and 29% agree that their child is encouraged to become mature and independent with just 1% unsure.
- All parents agree that their child feels safe at school 68% strongly agree and 32% agree.
- Most parents feel staff treat their child fairly at school 69% strongly agree and 27% agree, but 2% disagree and 1% are unsure.



Ethos and Attitudes

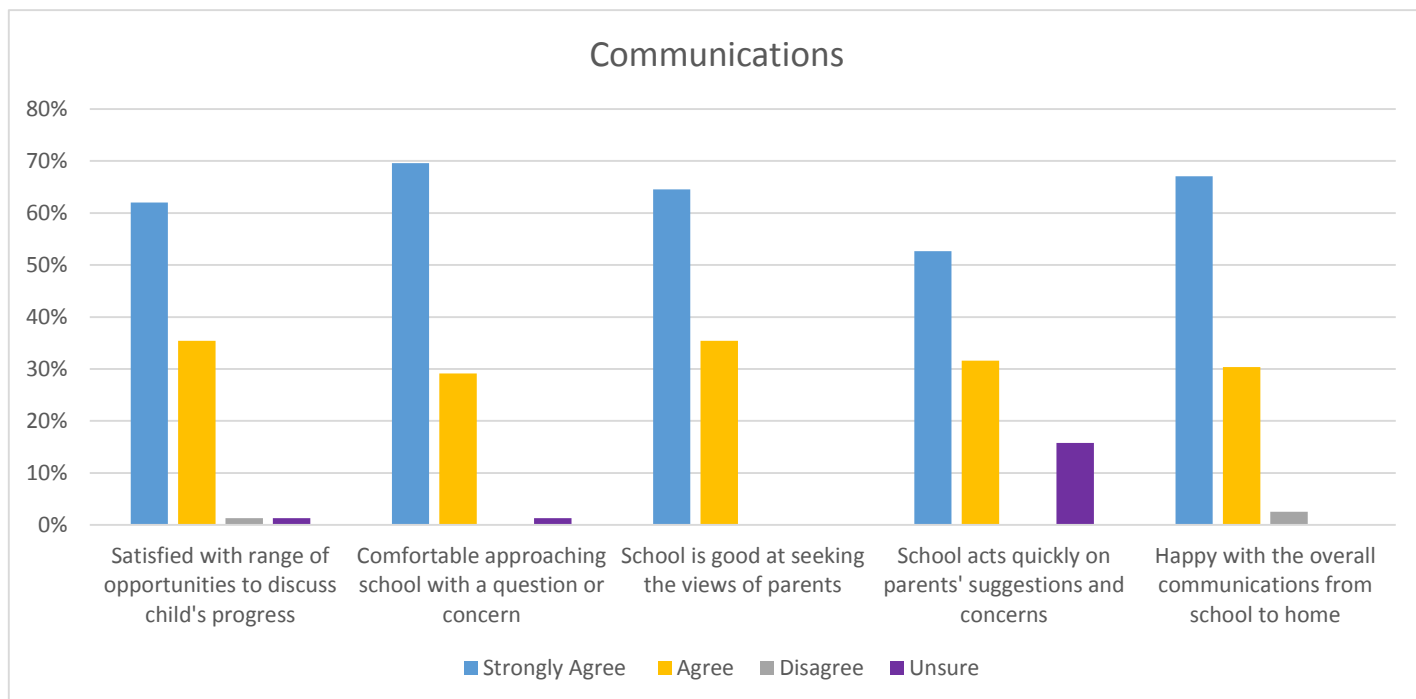
- The majority of parents agree that the school promotes worthwhile attitudes and values (64% strongly agree, 32% agree), however 4% are unsure.
- Most of the parents agree that the children are well behaved at school (59% strongly agree, 31% agree) 6% disagree and another 4% are unsure.
- 53% of parents strongly agree and 35% agree that the school is effective at dealing with behaviour issues while 1% disagree and 5% are unsure.



Communications

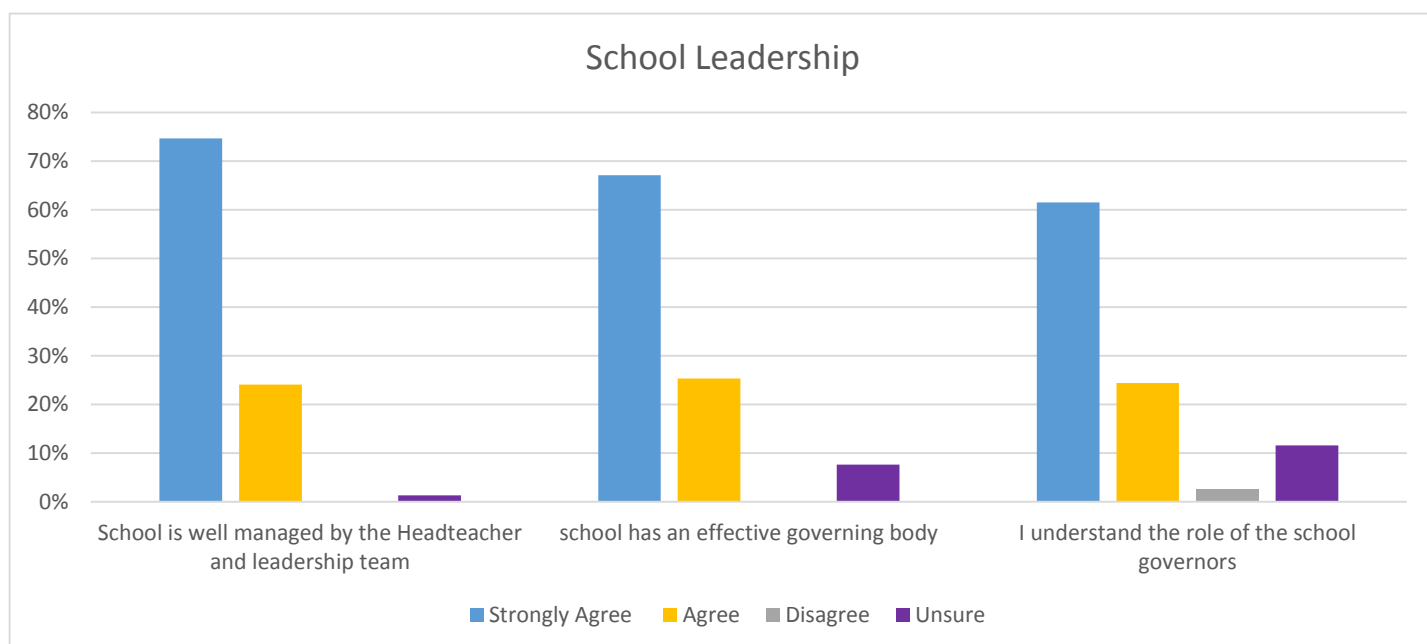
- The majority of parents strongly agree (62%) or agree (35%) that they are satisfied with the range of opportunities they have to discuss their child's progress. However 1% disagree and 1% are unsure.
- Most parents are comfortable approaching the school with a question or concern 70% strongly agree and 29% agree, 1% are unsure.
- Everyone agreed that the school is good at seeking views of parents 65% strongly agree and 35% agree
- 53% of parents strongly agree and 32% agree that the school acts quickly on parents' suggestions and concerns, yet 16% are unsure.

- The majority of parents are happy with the overall communication from school to home (67% strongly agree, 30% agree). However 3% disagree.



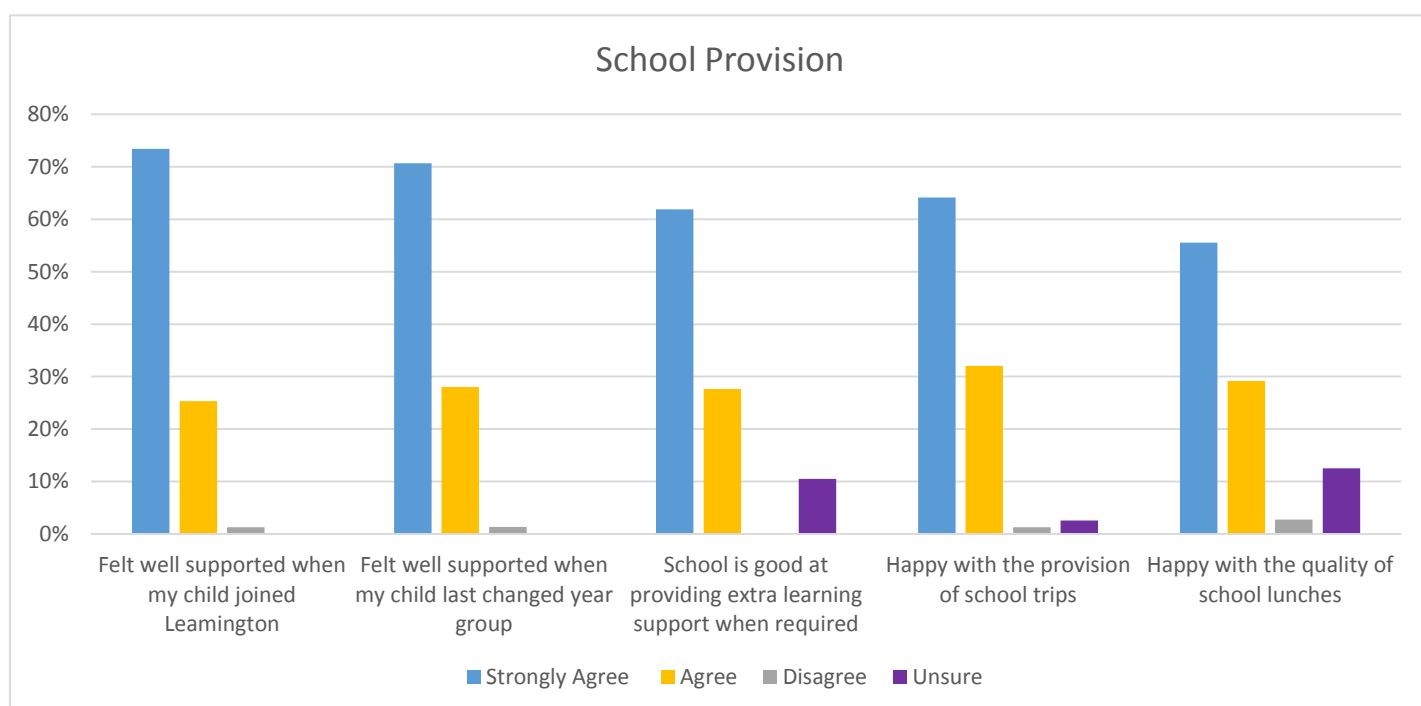
School Leadership

- 75% of parents strongly agree and 24% agree that the school is well managed by the Headteacher and leadership team with only 1% unsure.
- Most of the parents agreed (67% strongly agree, 25% agree) that the school has an effective governing body. However 8% were unsure.
- 62% of parents strongly agree and 24% of parents agree that they understand the role of school governors. 3% disagree and 12% are unsure.



School Provision

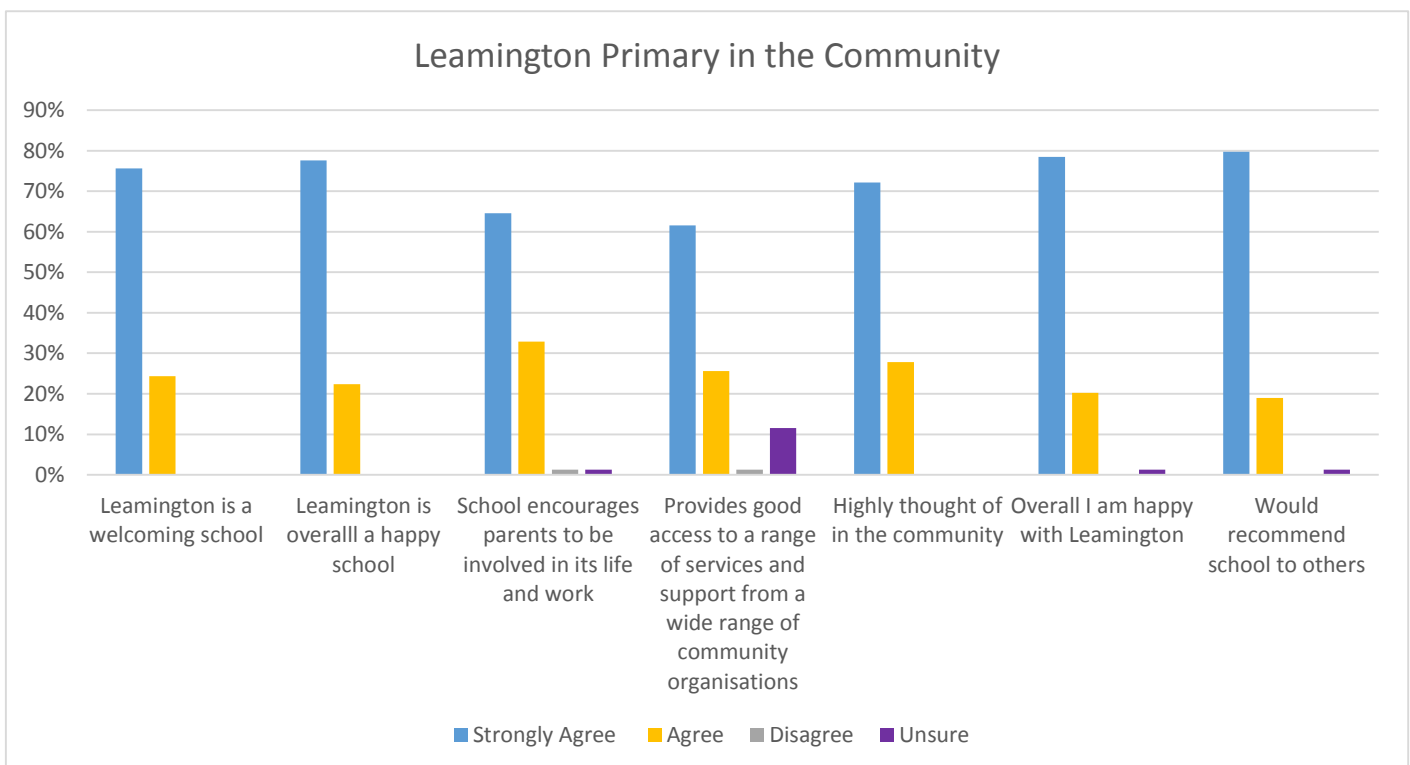
- When their child joined Leamington 73% strongly agree and 25% agree that they felt well supported. Only 1% disagree.
- When their child last changed year group 71% strongly agree and 28% agree that they felt supported, 1% disagree.
- The majority of parents agreed (62% strongly agree, 28% agree) that the school is good at providing extra learning support when required, with 11% saying they were unsure.
- 64% strongly agree and 32% agree that they are happy with the provision of school trips, while 1% disagree and a further 3% are unsure.
- 56% strongly agree and 29% agree that they are happy with the quality of school lunches, however 3% disagree and 13% are unsure.



Leamington in the Community

- All parents agree that Leamington is a welcoming school, 76% strongly agree and 24% agree.
- Everyone agreed that Leamington is an overall happy school, 78% strongly agree and 22% agree.
- The majority of parents agree that the school encourages parents to be involved in its life and work, 65% strongly agree and 33% agree. However 1% disagree and another 1% are unsure.

- 62% of parents strongly agree and 26% agree that Leamington provides good access to a range of services and support from a wide range of community organisations. 1% disagree and 12% are unsure.
- All parents agree, 72% strongly agree and 28% agree that Leamington is highly thought of in the community.
- Most parents are happy overall with Leamington, 78% strongly agree and 20% agree, with just 1% unsure.
- The majority of parents would recommend Leamington to others, 80% strongly agree and 19% agree with only 1% unsure.



What we do well

- Encourage parents to engage in activities in school like share a book.
- My child is fairly new to the school but up to now I am more than happy with everything and how fast he has settled in and how the school is.
- My daughter enjoys the extra activities after school, and values the resources the school provides.
- I am just happy with everything.

What we should improve
