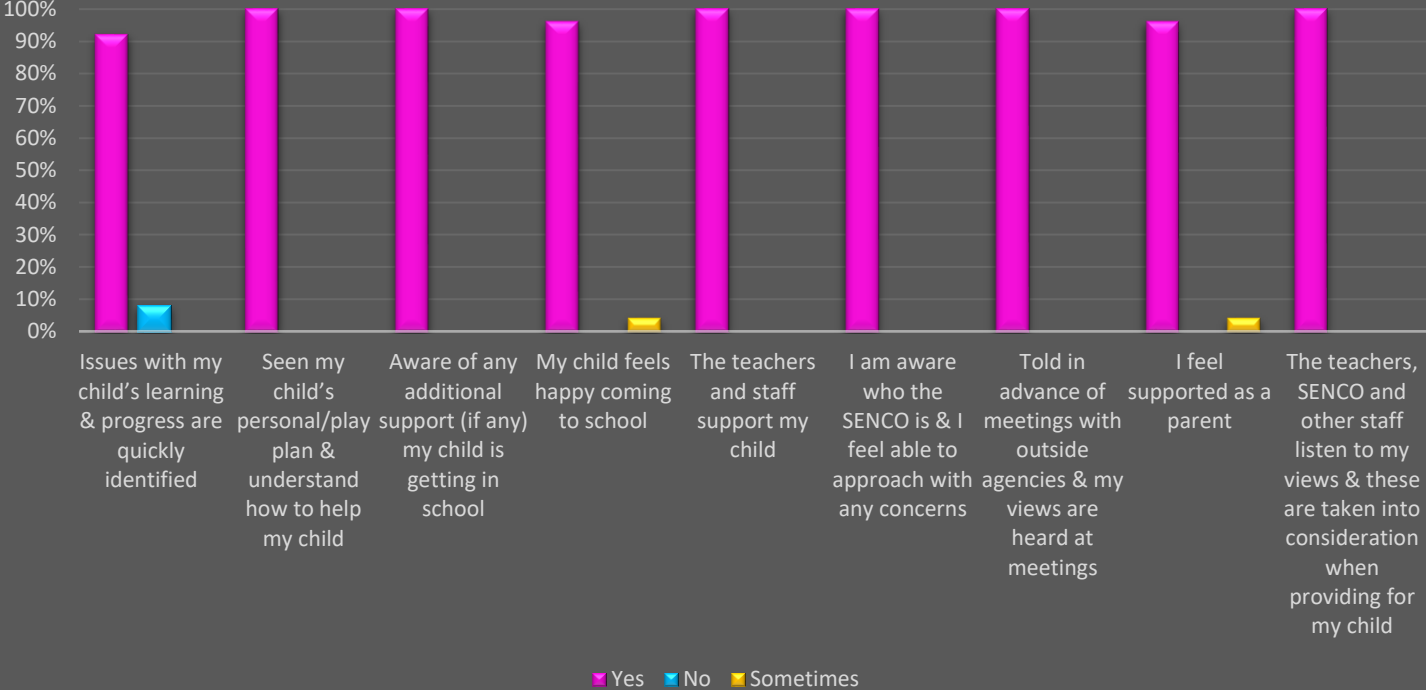

# SEND Parent View



July 2019

Based on 25 return questionnaires from parents of children on the SEND register at various stages.
