

**Guidance to Children and Parents of Year 6 children attending from 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020 at Leamington Community Primary School:**

*(Guidance issued June 2020 and to be implemented from June 15<sup>th</sup> 2020)*

- The provision for Y6 children will be open on June 15<sup>th</sup> until school closes on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July (subject to changes).
- We will be open from 8:45am to 3pm each day. Your child must arrive before 9am. If they walk alone then please do so. If they are dropped off it must only be one adult and that adult cannot come on to the yard. If they do not arrive before 9am they will not be able to enter the building and will have to return home. To enter the provision, your child must come through the outside door of the room allocated.
- The children will be leaving from 2:45pm and if they can walk home alone we recommend it. If not only one adult may come on to the yard to pick them up. You must remember social distancing rules at all times.
- They must not mull around on the yard they are to walk straight in to the classroom.
- Your child will be expected to use Handsan, step through a disinfectant tray before entering the building and have their temperature taken.
- We will be creating 3 bubbles (9 children) to start with and if numbers increase overtime we will introduce new bubbles. Each bubble will be allocated a classroom, teacher, Learning support officer and they will stay in this classroom with the same children whilst in the provision. The bubbles will not mix. They will not interact and your child will not see anyone from the other bubbles. Your child may not be with their original teacher before the pandemic started.
- **If your child shows any symptoms of Covid-19 you must not bring them to school. You must phone school and let us know. You will have to book a test (which is free) and isolate following current guidance. It is vital this is adhered to.**
- **If a child or adult in the bubble falls sick with Covid-19 that bubble (all children and adults) will isolate at home for 14 days you need to be prepared for this.**
- The room will be well ventilated and most of the furniture will be removed. Every child will have a table and a chair - which is their chair and will always be their chair.
- Whilst in the classroom, they will complete a number of tasks and activities. There will be opportunities for outdoor learning and exercise.
- Your child will be expected to wash their hands on a regular basis and stick to the 2m guidance.
- They will have strict playtimes and they will not be able to use any of the outside equipment.
- They will have allocated toilet times unless of an emergency.
- They will be given an iPad and other equipment which they are not to share with others.
- The work completed will be educational and cover basic skills and topic work suited for a range of children. Your child will be expected to carry on with their home learning when not at school.
- Your child must not bring anything in to the building. We will provide water, snacks and a hot meal each day. (A packed lunch could be given)
- Your child does not have to wear uniform and we recommend, once at home, they change their clothes and shower/bath. Please ensure fresh clothes are worn each day.
- We will not be marking any work but will provide verbal feedback.
- We will have limited movement around the building during the week and no visitors are allowed to enter the building. We will have a cleaner on duty each day and a deep clean will be carried out every evening.
- We have set up an emergency room for anyone feeling unwell and full PPE will be used.

- Staff are allowed to wear face masks if they want to and your child can also wear one if they want to. At all times, we must stick to the 2m rule and this will be reinforced with the children regularly.
- We will provide tissues and remind the child of the 'catch it, bin it, kill it'. We have bins with lids which will be emptied and cleaned each evening.
- We expect your child to behave as they normally would. The provision will be very different to how school was and this is to protect your child and our staff.
- We will have a trained first aider on site every day.
- Both Mr. Vine and Mrs. Mellor will be at school each day.

I want to reiterate that following the survey sent out we will only be offering places to the children that said they would be returning first. We will start with three bubbles with up to 9 children in each. Once this limit has been reached the bubble is then closed and no one can join or change including staff.

This will mean your child will not necessarily be with friends or their original class teacher. Your child might be with any teacher from across the school.

The 2m social distancing rules are paramount at all times and if your child does not stick to this they will be asked to leave the provision on the grounds of health and safety. Any child found to be coughing or spitting on purpose or for fun claiming they have the virus will be removed immediately and the school would look at excluding the child which would go on their record. The school would also consider allowing the Police to deal with the matter.

We have to make it clear this is not school as it was. This is school during a pandemic following strict guidance to ensure everyone is kept safe and well. The health and safety of the children and staff is our first priority.
