Take your pick! These are the homework options for this half term. Children should try and complete at least 2 but they can complete as many as they are able to during the half term. Children can share their completed pieces on Class dojo as and when they are finished.

For each task that you complete you can earn dojo points.



If you achieve the maximum number of dojo points (25 points) – you will be put into a raffle drawer for a special homework prize.

Go on a number hunt around your home. Which numbers did you find and where did you find them? (2 dojo points)	Research a variety of animals. What do they eat? Where do they live? This could be as a poster, PowerPoint, information leaflet....you choose! (5 dojo points)	Create a spelling poster to remember this week's phonics sounds. (2 dojo points)
Practice spelling tricky words e.g. they, what, with, when, was, my. (1 dojo point)	Learn to tie your shoe laces. (1 dojo point)	Play a game nicely with a family member. (1 dojo point)
Create an image in the style of Andy Warhol's pop art. This could be a drawing, painting, model or collage... you choose! (5 dojo points)	Practice your 5, 10 and 2 x times table. Can you spot a pattern? (1 dojo point)	How many traditional tales can you name? What is your favourite? (1 dojo point)
What can you find out about Neil Armstrong? Why is he a significant person in history? (2 dojo points)	Can you find out the favourite story of a family member and share it together? (2 dojo points)	Pick 2 numbers between 0 and 30. Add these numbers together to find the answer. Repeat this with different numbers. (2 dojo points)
