

English

We will be playing the part of police investigators and making sure we get the whole story to find out if the baddies are really as bad as the stories say they are! We will also be writing instructions and recipes for our favourite characters' treats.

The children will meet Red, a little boy who is struggling to concentrate at school. We will be thinking about wishes and writing stories about how we can make our wishes come true.

History/Geography

We will look in detail at the history of St. George's Hall including how, why and when it was built.

We will look carefully at the geography of Liverpool, where it sits in the country and the main human and physical features found here. We will use postcodes to locate places of interest in Liverpool.

Maths

We will look at addition and subtraction methods such as using a number line, blank number line and expanded columnar. The children will use these methods to solve a variety of problems and investigate number.

The children will also look at multiplication and division. They will use a range of practical and written strategies to solve problems.

R.E.

We will be looking in detail at the Christmas story. We will start by imagining what it was like for the shepherds on the hill when they received their good news. We will also think about the wise men and how they would have felt.
