Write five words with different suffixes (1 dojo point)	Find and record 10 past tense verbs in a news article. (2 dojo points)	Talk to a family member about their life when they were in school. (1 dojo point)
Find the cost from two receipts and add them together and find the difference. (1 dojo point)	Create a list of electrical items in your home and their properties. (1 dojo point)	Help around the house without being asked to. (2 dojo points)
Create a piece of Artwork of a local landmark/ building in your local area. (4 dojo points)	Create a 'Using Social Media Responsibly' poster either on paper or pic collage. (2 dojo points)	Multiply the ages of members in your family. What is the biggest number you can make? What is the smallest number you can make? (2 dojo points)
Plan a route from a famous Liverpool landmark to your house on Google Earth/ Digimap. (3 dojo points)	Write three positive things about yourself and read them each day for a week. (1 dojo point)	Create a project based on the Titanic presented in any way you wish. (5 dojo points)
