For each task that you complete you can earn dojo points.

Measure out 5 different amounts using a jug e.g. 100ml/500ml or 350ml. How are they different? (2 dojo points)	Research a variety of habitats in Asia. Draw them and write a sentence to describe each of them. (5 dojo points)	Create a spelling poster to remember this week's phonics sounds. (2 dojo points)
Practice spelling tricky words e.g. would, should, climb, children. (1 dojo point)	Learn to tie your shoe laces. (1 dojo point)	Read your favourite book at home before bed. (1 dojo point)
Draw the Chinese flag and draw two animals that link to China. (5 dojo points)	Practice your 3 times tables. Write them in a list. (1 dojo point)	Name all of the 7 continents. (1 dojo point)
Draw your own willow pattern plate. (2 dojo points)	Can you learn a new song and perform it to a family member? (2 dojo points)	List your favourite things to do to cheer yourself up when you feel low. (2 dojo points)
