Take your pick! These are the homework options for this half term. Children should try and complete at least 2 but they can complete as many as they are able to during the half term. Children can send a photograph of their completed pieces on Dojo so their teacher can share it with the class.



Plant a seed and watch it grow. Some examples of seeds you could plant are apple seeds; sunflower seeds or orange seed.	Take care of your seed or a plant in your garden by watering it regularly and making sure it has enough light to grow.	Do some research and find out which animals hatch from eggs.
Research the life cycle of an animal that hatches from an egg.	Draw a picture of something that is growing in your garden or something that you see while out and about.	Can you try tasting a new fruit or vegetable that you have never tasted before?
Share a story with an adult in your family?	Can you talk about the difference between a story book and a non-fiction book?	Think of your favourite story, maybe one we have done in Nursery. Can you talk about what happens in the beginning; the middle and the end of the story?
Following our work on the Hungry Caterpillar can you practice learning the days of the week. Maybe you can find a song with the days of the week in it.	Practice writing your name. What sound does your name begin with? Can you write anyone else's name?	Can you follow a recipe with an adult in your house? You will have to measure and weigh some ingredients
