## What will my child need for September?

- School uniform



- A warm, waterproof coat- we play out in all weathers!!!
- Sensible shoes (black) that your child can fasten- Velcro. Please **NO** shoe laces!
- A book bag which are available to buy at the school office.
- PE kit- white t shirt, black or navy blue shorts and black pumps.
- A photograph of your family- (we display them in class to make the children feel at home)
- Packed lunch as appropriate.



**Please make sure all clothing is clearly labelled!!!!**

Although we do our best, it is easy to mix up and lose uniform that isn't named especially with 60 4 and 5 year olds.

# How can I prepare my child for starting school?



We encourage the children to be as independent as possible right from the start

- Allow your child to practice getting dressed into their school uniform independently, taking on and off shoes- this will really help with PE.
  - Encourage your child to put on and fasten their own coat.
- If your child is going to have a packed lunch ensure they can open the packets and wrappers.
- Share books and stories, once in Reception children are encouraged to read at home every night.
  - Sing number rhymes and play counting games.
- Play games encouraging your child to read and write their name.
  - Play turn taking games.
- Encourage your child to tidy up what they have been playing with.
- Remind them to wash their hands after using the toilet and before eating a meal.

# Our School Day



At the start of the day, a teacher will be on duty from 8:50am. Children will wait by our gate until a teacher lets them in. Please encourage your child to stay nearby you before entering school.

At the end of the day, you are able to access the school playground from 2:55pm and you will collect your child from outside our classroom doors. Please let us know if someone different is coming to collect your child, if we are unsure they will remain at school until we can contact you and had confirmation.

## Lunch Time



All children will be provided with a free school meal.

If you do not want your child to have a free school meal please inform school in writing ASAP.

If you prefer you can send your child to school with a packed lunch each day. Remember we are a healthy school so try to keep lunches as healthy as possible.

Suggestions for a packed lunch:

- **Clearly named** packed lunch box
  - Sandwich/wrap
  - Yoghurt
  - Fruit
  - Crisps/biscuit
- Water or fruit juice- **NO FIZZY DRINKS**
- **NO SWEETS**



Any questions please ask. Remember not to give them too much food.

Children are also provided with a healthy breakfast and snack every day.

Snacks vary each day and include apples, pears, bananas, carrots and raisins. The children will be offered milk to drink or children can bring in their own, clearly labelled water bottle.
