<p>Practice your pre-cursive handwriting by practising your weekly spellings. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Make a poster about reversible and irreversible changes. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Create a poster of <u>Charles Babbage</u> and his invention of the first computer. (1 dojo point)</p>
