I am delighted to inform you that the final Ofsted inspection report from our two-day section 5 inspection on 16th and 17th May 2023 accompanies this covering letter. The report will also be accessible via the school website today and published on the official Ofsted report website, eight working days from today's date.

The purpose of a section 5 inspection is to fully inspect a school and make judgements in 5 key areas:

- The quality of education
- Behaviour and attitudes
- Personal development
- Leadership and management
- Early years provision

I am delighted that the hard work undertaken by the Leamington Community Primary School staff and the support of parent/carers and our wider community has been recognised, including the comments regarding our work on improving attendance, our interesting and ambitious curriculum, personal development, the effective systems in place, the supportive team and leadership, commitment of the pupils and the impact of the quality of education underpinned by the work we do for students with SEND.

The report itself is very detailed and highlights the many elements of effective provision at Leamington as well as the next steps needed to take the school forward. What is very satisfying is that the next steps identified were already within our development plan prior to this inspection and the associated adaptations are being implemented.

Please take the time to read the inspection report in full as it evidences a school that is not only good, but one that continuously strives to improve and excel.
