For each task that you complete you can earn dojo points.

Practice your 4 and 6 times tables. You could use Timestable Rockstars if you wish. (2 dojo points)	Create a project South Africa. This could be in the form of an information text, PowerPoint, 3D model, artwork etc. (5 dojo points)	Record or list the different the planets in order from the sun. (2 dojo points)
Use this week's spelling to practice your handwriting (1 dojo point)	Make a poster about this week's Key Vocabulary that we discovered in our Geography and Science lessons, (1 dojo point)	Make a collage about space using cut-outs from magazines, newspapers or posters. (1 dojo point)
Create a project about space. Ideas: use a box to create your backdrop, polystyrene planets, posters, paintings etc (5 dojo points)	Practice your 9 times table. Can you spot a pattern? (1 dojo points)	Show your understanding of the different phases of the moon. Be as creative as you can be. (2 dojo points)
Create a game about one of our topics. (2 dojo points)	Complete an act of kindness. (1 dojo point)	Read 10 minutes each night for a full week. Don't forget your reading record. (2 dojo points)
