For each task that you complete you can earn dojo points.

List the ways we use fractions in the real world. (2 dojo points)	Research what land use is! How is land used in Norris Green? How about Liverpool? Present this as a poster. (5 dojo points)	Create a spelling poster to remember this week's spellings. (1 dojo point)
Watch the news and tell me about one main event. Is there a way we could help? (1 dojo point)	Explore different patterns in your environment. Create a poster using them. This could be photographs, tree rubbings or collage. (2 dojo points)	Research the Scientist/Inventor Charles F Brush and create a poster about his work. (2 dojo points)
Visit our city centre. How is the land used? (2 dojo points)	Practice your 3 and 8 x times table. Can you spot a pattern? (1 dojo points)	Write a book review for a mystery story. (1 dojo points)
Research Jewish beliefs. (2 dojo points)	Spend 20 minutes organising something that is a mess – bedroom, desk, cupboard etc. (1 dojo point)	Write a letter or email to someone that you know would love to hear from you. (5 dojo points)
