English

Maths

We will begin this half term be starting our measures topic. We will look at how to convert between different units of measure and look into imperial units.

After that, we will be finding the area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes. Finally, we will then be exploring 3D shapes and their properties.

R.E Christianity

We will be exploring less familiar stories of Christianity. We will explore different aspects of the Christian faith by meeting characters including Daniel and John the Baptist.

Year 5 Home/School Sheet

<u>PE</u>

PE lessons with LSSP will take place Thursday afternoon. The topic we will be looking at is Gymnastics. Children will begin with some basic rolling and move on to creating balances with their partners and creating sequences.

Science
