English

This half term we are basing all our work around the narrative of Perseus and Medusa. The children will be describing settings, heroes and monsters from famous Greek Myths. This will culminate in them writing their own version of a Greek Myth where they will create all the elements.

Our unit of work on play scripts will be used to retell the Greek myths and Legends.

<u>Maths</u>

We will then progress to shape, we will create shapes in different orientations and investigate their properties using vocabulary such as vertices, edges, angle etc

During our RE topic, we will be looking at Islamic rites of passage. To begin with, we will look at the five pillars are. We will then move on to look at Muslim birth ceremonies and naming days. Further on in the topic we will look at marriage and funeral ceremonies.
