Can you partition the number into tens and ones? <math>16 = 1 \text{ ten and } 6 \text{ ones}</math> (2 dojo points)</p>	<p>Find objects made of different materials. Collect them and then present it. This could be as a poster, bringing them into school or sending a picture on dojo – you choose! (5 dojo points)</p>	<p>Create a spelling poster to remember this week's spellings. (2 dojo points)</p>
<p>Share a book with a family member. Talk about what you liked about this book. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Learn to tie your shoe laces. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Write your numbers from 0 – 20 in words. (1 dojo point)</p>
<p>Create an image in the style of Ben Johnson. This could be a drawing, painting, model or collage... you choose! (5 dojo points)</p>	<p>Practice your 5, 10 and 2 x times table. Can you spot a pattern? (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>How many traditional tales can you name? What is your favourite? (1 dojo point)</p>
<p>What can you find out about St George's Hall? (2 dojo points)</p>	<p>Can you take some photos at home? It could be of people, objects, nature. Send us in your photos via dojo. (2 dojo points)</p>	<p>Play a game with a family member using a ball. (2 dojo points)</p>
