Children can bring their completed pieces into school or share photos/ comments on dojo as and when they are finished. For each task that you complete you can earn dojo points.

Ask a member of your family about how they manage their emotions (1 dojo point)	Write a positive message to brighten up someone's day and give it to them (1 dojo point)	Create a Maths board game. (4 dojo points)
Write a story set in an imaginary world using the four following paragraphs: introduction, build up, problem and resolution (4 dojo points)	Do 60 minutes of exercise (2 dojo points)	Practice your 3 times tables (1 dojo point)
Write out 5 sentences including words ending in 'ture' (2 dojo points)	Visit 'hour of code' and complete at least two levels of coding. Learn (hourofcode.com) (1 dojo point)	Interview someone in your family about their job. Find out the best thing about their job. (1 dojo point)
Create a model of a 'public space' such as a pavilion using any materials (5 dojo points)	Find examples of solids that can melt and liquids that can be boiled or frozen to change state (2 dojo points)	Learn a new fact about the Romans and share with the class (1 dojo point)
