

English

Our English topic will be focused around the book 'Whatever Next'. Children will be looking at and exploring recounts and children will enjoy travelling to space through storytelling. Children will continue using and applying their phonics knowledge when writing sentences. There will also be huge focus on phonics throughout this half term, practicing sounds, nonsense words (alien words) and reading longer words too in preparation for the Phonics Screening Check in June.

History

This half term children will be exploring significant figures. We will look at Neil Armstrong and the Wright brothers whilst comparing the effect the Wright Brothers had on Neil Armstrong and the impact their invention has made on the world today.

Maths

During this half term we will finish our topic of money and then we will be concentrating on geometry and measurement. We will first explore 2D and 3D shapes focusing on their properties and where they can be found in the environment. We will then move onto measurement, weight and capacity. Children will explore both standard and non-standard measure and use a variety of concrete manipulatives and resources.

R.E/PSHE

During R.E. we will be exploring Hinduism. Children will explore what Hindu's celebrate, their sacred text and their special festivals they celebrate. Throughout PHSE we will be following the scheme Jigsaw.

Computing

During this half term, we will be further developing our skills on computers. We will be exploring the topic of Digital Painting and we will be using the paint app to develop our understanding of a range of tools used for digital painting before creating our own pieces of digital art.

Science

During science this half term we will be looking at different materials. We will explore different materials and their properties; such as transparency, strength, waterproof. We will be testing and identifying the different materials suitable to build a rocket and make a space suit.

Art

We will be exploring the work of Andy Warhol this half term. We will enjoy researching Andy Warhol and learn about the techniques and equipment needed to create a piece of artwork using his style of Pop Art.
